



 - Move the slider to adjust the caption size








Project Overview

- Full Station Reconstruction:
 - Two new fully accessible, high-level, side platforms with canopies.
 - Three new elevators, two new ramps and three sets of covered stairs.
 - New lighting, signage and wayfinding security cameras, and other amenities.
 - New tracks, ties, ballast, bridge plates and communication duct banks.
- Total Construction Cost: \$50 Million



Installation of concrete barriers along fence line at Aberjona Lot (April 4, 2022)











Upcoming Construction: What To Expect this Summer

- Continued Demolition work and Micropile Installation:
 - Starting on the South End and moving North
 - Neighbors can expect increased noise from construction activity including heavy equipment and machinery
- Work will primarily take place during the day, Monday –
 Friday, 7am 5pm
- Waterfield Road Closure: Weekend of July 9th–July 10th and July 16th – July 17th, from 6am-6pm. Waterfield Parking Lot to remain open on these weekends. Police details will be on site
- Construction advisories will be distributed ahead of any scheduled night or weekend work, if necessary

Parking and Traffic Impacts



- Parking impacts began April 4th and will continue through completion of project.
- Laraway Road will remain closed for duration of project.
- Portions of Waterfield
 Parking Area and Aberjona
 Parking Area unavailable
 during construction.
- Temporary parking displacement on Waterfield Road, adjacent to Laraway Road to accommodate temporary crosswalk.
- Occasional parking and traffic impacts at Waterfield Road during construction.

Travel Alternatives from Winchester Center Station



Route 134 Bus

- North Woburn to Wellington Station (Orange Line).
- 0.2 Miles (about a 4-minute walk) from Winchester Center
 Station to stop located at corner of Main and Vine Streets.

Wedgemere Station

- North Station (Boston) to Lowell Station (Lowell Line)
- 0.7 Miles (about a 3-minute drive) from Winchester Center Station.
- O.6 Miles (about an 11-minute walk) from Winchester Center Station by Tri-Community Greenway.
- Walk, bike, or drive (parking and bike storage available).
